

GM ST. CATHARINES—START OF SHIFT ADDENDUM

Plant Director, Carolyn Watts announced today, Thursday, September 19, that commencing **Monday, September 23**, both **Gen V** and **HFV6** will be impacted by the UAW work stoppage and employees will be placed on temporary layoff until further notice.

Gen V and **HFV6** employees required to come to work during this temporary layoff will be notified directly by their supervisor prior to their last shift this week.

*While on temporary layoff, **HFV6** and **Gen V** employees are required to call the **GM St. Catharines Information Hotline (1-877-868-3895)** each day **two hours** before their regularly scheduled shifts for updates regarding work stoppage and/or return to work plans.*

Additionally, although **GF6** employees are *not* currently impacted by the UAW work stoppage and required to work regularly scheduled shifts during the week of September 23, all **GF6 employees** will be temporarily laid off for the **week of September 30** due to customer demand and in line with CAMI Assembly's operating plan.

Employees required to work during this time will be notified directly by their supervisor.

*Should the UAW work stoppage impact **GF6** by extending their temporary layoff the **Emergency Information Hotline (1-877-868-3895)** will be updated to reflect return to work times. **GF6 employees are required to call the hotline two hours** before their regularly scheduled shift on **October 6/7, 2019** for return to work information.*
