Nomination box will open at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 26, 2019 and will close at 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 3, 2019.

Nomination box and forms are available at the UNIFOR. Union Hall, 124 Bunting Road, St. Catharines, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday to Friday.

If necessary, an **advance vote** will be available on **October 9, 2019 from 1:45 p.m. to 3:45 p.m.** upstairs at the Union hall. A **hall vote** will take place on **Wednesday, October 16, 2019.** (which is the same date as the monthly General Membership meeting and Retirees meeting). Actual voting time will be on the Notice of Election to follow.

Anyone elected to a position must attend at least two (2) General Membership Meetings in a three (3) month period, or will be removed from office pursuant to local union bylaws.
