

IMPORTANT OPERATING PLAN NOTICE

As communicated yesterday (March 18, 2020), General Motors announced that all GM manufacturing plants across North America will be temporarily suspended, and our GF6 transmission operation will be on temporary layoff starting Monday, March 23, 2020.

Also starting Monday, March 23, assembly and machining shifts in the HFV6 engine operation will also be temporarily laid off until further notice due to customer demand in line with Lansing Delta Township's operating plan.

Any HFV6 employees required to work during this time will be notified directly by their supervisor.

Gen V will continue to operate two full shifts to support our customers—the GM assembly plants in Arlington, Texas and Silao, Mexico—which are still in operation at this time.

We are working with our Unifor partners to ensure the health and safety of our employees remains our top priority during this time.

Impacted GF6, HFV6 and Gen V employees are required to call the Emergency Information Hotline (1-877-868-3895) two hours before their regularly scheduled shift starting Monday, March 23, 2020 for any changes to the operating schedule.

Finally, I know that with all the uncertainty in the world, it's difficult to come to work each and every day. On behalf of the leadership of GM, I appreciate your focus and how we continue to work together in this time of uncertainty.
